

DEUSTO HALL OF RESIDENCE

2021/2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

1.ACCOMMODATION AND FORM OF PAYMENT:

Payment includes:

Accommodation: Individual room (en-suite bathroom, Internet connection, telephone and piped music); a complete set of bed linen and towels; use of common rooms (TV, music, study, fine arts, cafeteria, games room, etc.) and the use of sports facilities (football field, basketball court, five-a-side football, squash court) and gym (weightlifting room, gym room and multifunctional training). There is also a laundry available for residents.

Full board: All meals are self-service: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

1.2. **For one-month stays or longer, 7-day, full-board accommodation**, from Monday to Sunday the price is **€38.48/day (plus 10% VAT)**, only applicable to individual rooms. This rate requires continuous stay without interruption, except for specified holiday periods, where payment will include the last and first working days of Hall operation.

In exceptional circumstances, the Residence Hall reserves the right to change fees.

1.3. **Price for less than one-month stay (plus 10%VAT):**

- BED + BREAKFAST (B&B):
Single room: €43,49 / Double room: €65,25
- HALF BOARD (H.B.):
Single room: €46,76 / Double room: €69,94
(Includes Breakfast + Dinner. No lunch)
- FULL BOARD (F.B.):
Single room: €51,11 / Double room: €80,86

(Price per person and day for a single room. In the case of double rooms, the fee is per room)

2. OTHER RULES:

2.1. The Hall will close on Christmas and Easter.

For reservations for a month or longer, it is necessary to pay a month's rent in advance, corresponding to the last month of stay. If you do not comply with the previously agreed accommodation period, your payment will not be refunded. DEUSTO HALL OF RESIDENCE: Rules

I. WHAT IS COLEGIO MAYOR DEUSTO?

Colegio Mayor Deusto is a residence hall of the Jesuit Order founded by the University of Deusto with the official approval of the Spanish government on February 18, 1961. The hall has been thoroughly renovated in July 2002.

The AIMS of this residence hall are:

- a) To promote a spirit of coexistence in the student community which will enrich their comprehensive education on the human, civic, social, religious, and ethical areas.
- b) To nurture a sense of responsibility, especially through study and participation in cultural, sports and leisure activities.
- c) To encourage students to actively participate in the social environment they will be living in.
- d) To inculcate a spirit of freedom, good habits, work ethics, and solidarity among students.
- e) To provide students with the adequate environment for their personality to develop.

II. RESIDENCE HALL RULES

- Use of common facilities

Proper use of common items shows the degree of development of our **social responsibility**. This becomes visible in our respect towards those facilities and, especially, in the care and cleaning of these spaces, where coexistence is most frequent.

Bedrooms

Students will have their own room, which will have to be kept **tidy and clean**. The way objects and furniture are arranged cannot be an obstacle for the work of the cleaning staff. Every student is responsible for the preservation of their room and furniture.

Necessary repairs can be requested at the Reception desk by filling out the appropriate forms.

Room change petitions will be communicated to the Director, who will consider those petitions.

Timetables

The **right** to study, rest, and enjoy privacy that every student in their room is entitled to should not pose a conflict with the chores of the staff at Colegio Mayor. Since all residents are University students, it is assumed they will get up at a reasonable time in order to carry out their academic duties.

Silence is a must from midnight on. Students arriving later than midnight or who are still around after midnight will need to be very careful not to disturb those students who are already asleep. If the student breaks this rule, they can be reprimanded by the Director, and, if necessary, other kinds of disciplinary measures will be taken.

After midnight, all students will have to fill out a card indicating the time of their return to the Residence Hall.

Absences

When a student is out for the weekend, they need to let the receptionist know their destination and will also need to leave their key. Students who are planning on spending a night outside Colegio Mayor will need to let the Director know.

Dining room

It is a self-service system with fixed meal times. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided. Every student will need to show their Colegio Mayor resident card when entering the dining room.

Visits

Visitors will be welcomed at the Reception lobby by the student whom they come to visit. These floors have restricted access for the opposite sex. All visitors must leave Colegio Mayor by midnight. Special permissions may be granted by the Director.

- Areas and restrictions

The bedroom area in the residence hall is divided in ladies' floors and a men's floors. The coed areas are the cafeteria, the dining room, the living room, the TV room, the library, etc.

Parties

All celebrations, dinner parties, birthday parties, etc, within Colegio Mayor must be approved by the Director. Celebrations must always abide by the rules of the Hall.

Attitudes

Residents need to respect the staff at Colegio Mayor. Should there be any complaint about the service provided, it should be communicated to the Director.

All group activities should remain open to the resident community.

Every student is required to dress decently and to show good manners when surrounded by other people, especially in the dining room.

The following activities are forbidden: alcohol drinking in the bedrooms, gambling, using drugs, fraternity pranks, and throwing objects out of the windows.

Penalties

If a resident breaks any of the rules above, and after the corresponding verbal warning, they repeat this kind of behavior, they will be subject to a penalization. If the resident commits a serious offence, they will be expelled from the Residence Hall.
